

FULL AUTO BLAST

RULES: Practical Shooting Handbook, Latest Edition **COURSE DESIGNER:** Michael D'Angelo

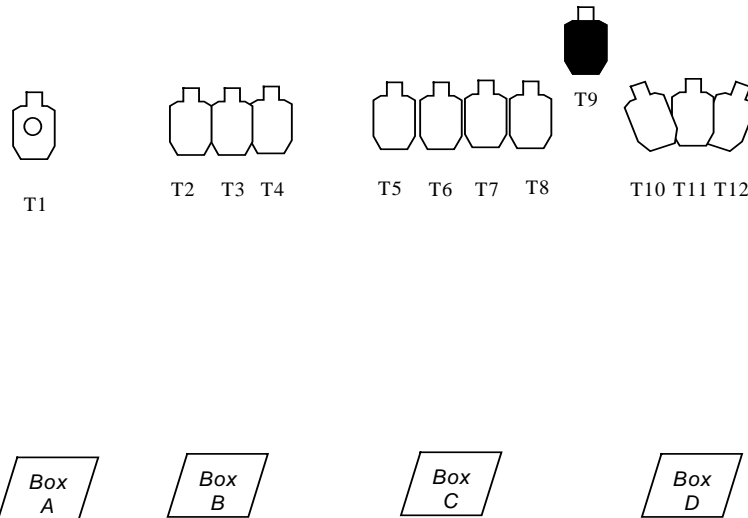
START POSITION: Standing in box A with gun to shoulder facing target.

STAGE PROCEDURE

On signal Shooter will dump a full magazine (minimum 30 rounds) into the paper plate on T1. All rounds outside of the paper plate will be a miss with 10 points for each round not on the plate. Shooter moves to box B where he will engage T2-T4 from a point-shooting stance with one continuous burst. He will then move to Box C and engage T5-T8 from a point-shooting stance with one continuous burst. In between Box C and D shooter will engage T9 from his shoulder. (Note: body is hard covered.) Shooter then moves to Box D and engages T10-T12 from a point-shooting stance with one continuous burst. Must have a minimum of 8 points on each target T2-T12. If shooter stops the burst while engaging the target "clusters" from each box, he will be assessed a penalty (10 seconds) for each stop. Repeat the stage.

SCORING

SCORING: Time plus penalties
TARGETS: 12 IPSC, 6 bases, 1 paper plate
SCORED HITS: 2 Best. A=5 (A-head=8), B=4, C=3, D=1
START-STOP: Audible - Last shot
PENALTIES: Procedural. -10
 No-shoot hit. -10
 Miss. -10



SETUP NOTES: Maximum distance between shooting box and targets is 10 yards. T9 has hard cover up to the neck.

RO NOTES: Watch muzzle and make sure shooter has control at all times.
